CRITERIA:

- 1. Pacific Islander students (Chamorro (Guam, Marianas), Fijian, Hawaiian, Maori, Marshallese, Samoan, Tahitian, Tongan, and others) in grades 6-12, or college or university are eligible for the NPIEN Christina Diaz Student Scholar Award.
2. Students may be nominated by their school teacher, professor, counselor, or administrator.
3. Students are selected based on their academic achievement (minimum 2.5 GPA), improved academic achievement, and participation in school and community service and extracurricular activities.
4. Five college and /or high school students will be selected for a minimum \$500 scholarship based on this application. Two middle school students receive a \$100 scholarship. All students will be recognized at the awards ceremony with a medallion and multiple certificates.
