

SOME HIGHLIGHTS

- Since 2001, 24 annual education conferences have been held, serving 4,600 attendees.



- 509 students have received the Christina and Ray Diaz Student Scholars Awards (Grades K-12 & College)
- 205 students have received scholarships, for a total of over \$65,055 in distributed funds.
- 85 educators received the Sevia Ma'ae Educator Award, 75 community partners the Dr. Alofa Tanuvasa Community Award, and 4 Counselors received our new Sala Auelua Counselor Award.
- The Falana'I Ala Speaker and Mentor series reaches 1,000 elementary, middle school and high school and college students annually.
